The Public works department appreciates the patience shown while repairs are being made to the low level crossing on RR45 and replacement of the culvert on TWP RD 781 which were damaged as a result of the recent flooding. TWP RD 781 was reopened June 27th and the low level should be repaired by July 8th if we do not receive any significant rainfall.



ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Construction on the upgrade of the Intersection at RR 55 and Highway 49 also known as the Weaver Auction and Palko Intersection will be commencing Mid July. Knelsen Rock Products is the contractor performing these upgrades and they want to assure the public that they will be doing their best not to disrupt traffic however there will be flag people and reduced lane widths from time to time. They anticipate the project to take 23 days to completion but are planning on working six days a week 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, not on Sundays. Everyone involved would appreciate the public's patience during this time of construction and ask that you avoid the area if possible. Knelsen is in contact with Weavers and Palko and do not wish to disrupt these businesses but require completing this project in line with their schedule of work for this summer. The goal is to complete this project on time safely with as little disruption as possible.
