TAX NOTICES 2023

Notice is hereby given that the assessment and tax notices for the 2023 taxation year have been mailed on June 8, 2023 and will be payable on or before September 15th, 2023. All assessments and tax notices are deemed to have been received seven (7) days after mailing within Alberta and fourteen (14) days outside of the province.

Anyone wishing to object to the assessment value on any property in their name must, within 60 days of receiving this notice, lodge their complaint using only the prescribed “Assessment Review Board Complaint” form “#LGS1402 (2009/08)” to the Assessment Review Board Clerk care of Louise Gostick, Assistant Administrator of the Municipal District of Spirit River No. 133, Box 389, 4202 – 50th St. Spirit River, AB T0H 3G0.

The complaint must be accompanied by a \$50.00 fee for Residential - 3 or fewer dwellings and Farmland; \$650 fee for Residential- 4 or more dwellings and Non-residential, which will be refunded to the complainant if the complaint is successful. A copy of “Filing a Property Assessment Complaint and Preparing for Your Hearing” booklet as well as a “Guide to Property Assessment and Taxation in Alberta” can be obtained at the Municipal District of Spirit River No. 133 office. Complaints must be submitted in writing on or before Tuesday August 15, 2023.

SECURE ENERGY LANDFILL OPEN TO MD RATEPAYERS ONLY

MD residents will be asked to show their Landfill Usage Card upon entering the landfill site. Regular landfill take-in days: *Wednesday, Thursday & Friday – 9am-5pm. Saturday – 10am-4pm. CONTROLLED BURNS NOTIFICATIONS

Please notify us before you burn. Those who do not advise of controlled burns are subject to a \$500 fine. These rules apply year-round. When calling for a burn notification, please contact the MD Office at (780) 864-3500 Monday through Friday before 4:15pm.

WATER RESERVOIR

The Municipal District of Spirit River has opened its water reservoir to MD residents to aid in replenishing water for dugouts. The MD Reservoir is located on TWP RD 780 West of RR 60. Landfill cards that have been issued with an expiration date do not need to be renewed unless you are renting your land. If you own your property and your Landfill Card has an expiration date on it, please disregard this expiration date. Your Landfill card will remain active until you have either reached your load limit, you have sold your land, or if you have lost your Landfill privileges.
