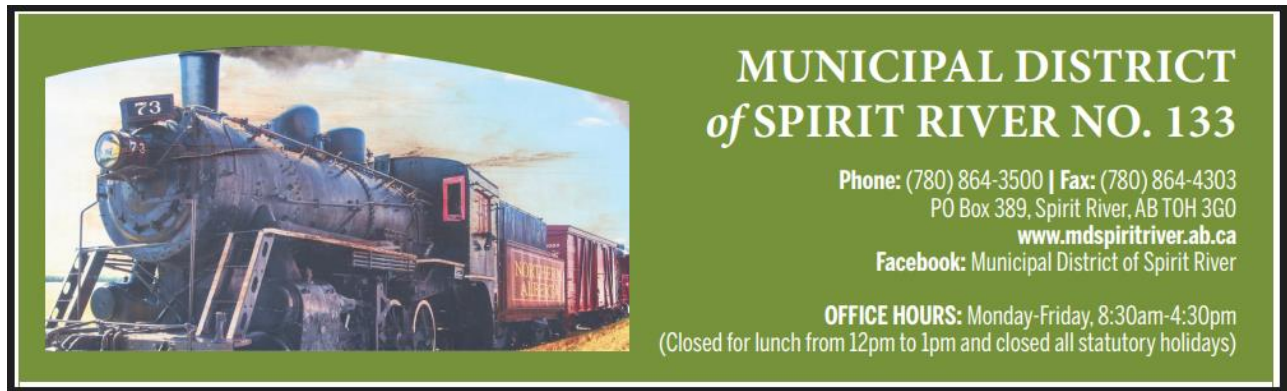




February 15,2024 Newsletter

The next Council Meeting will be held on March 6,2024 at 9:00am in the Council Chambers located in the MD Office in Spirit River. Council meetings are open to the public and we welcome you to attend. Some of the following motions were made at our Council Meeting on Feb.7th2024.

033.02.07.24 Moved by Councillor Nick vanRootselaar that the Municipal District of Spirit River No.133 will support the development and use of Small Modular Reactors within the Municipal District and direct administration to pursue opportunities to attract Small Modular Reactor development in the MD.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

035.02.07.24 Moved by Councillor Nick vanRootselaar that the Municipal District of Spirit River No.133 make a financial contribution to the Grande Spirit Foundation in the amount of \$10,000.00 to be directed to the official grand opening of the new Pleasantview Lodge with funds to come from reserves, further that, additionally the MD contribute in-kind services including the use of the Municipal District Transit Bus for the June 1st , 2024 grand opening.

LANDFILL CARD UPDATE

Attention MD Residents,

Landfill cards that have been issued with an expiration date do not need to be renewed unless you are renting your land. If you own your property and your Landfill Card has an expiration date on it, please disregard this expiration date. Your Landfill card will remain active until you have either reached your load limit, you have sold your land, or if you have lost your Landfill privileges. If you are renting in the MD of Spirit River and your Landfill Card has expired, please stop by the office for renewal.

The Municipal District of Spirit River's Private Lane Snowplowing Policy PWS.03 offers snowplowing services to seniors and handicapped persons. The snowplowing services are available at the following rates for each snow removal:

- i) Seniors – \$125.00 plus G.S.T.
- ii) Handicapped Persons – 125.00 plus G.S.T.
- iii) Spouses of Seniors and/or Handicapped Persons – \$125.00 plus G.S.T.
- iv) Dependants of Seniors and/or Handicapped Persons – \$125.00 plus G.S.T.
