# 2025 PROPERTY TAX NOTICES



Notice is hereby given that the **Assessment and Tax Notices** for the 2025 Taxation Year will be mailed on May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025, and will be payable **on or before September 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025**. All assessments and tax notices are deemed to have been received seven (7) days after mailing within Alberta and fourteen (14) days outside of the province.

Anyone wishing to object to the assessment value on any property in their name **MUST**, within 60 days of receiving this notice, lodge their complaint using only the prescribed "**Assessment Review Board Complaint**" form to the Assessment Review Board Clerk care of Louise Gostick, Municipal District of Spirit River No. 133, Box 389, 4202 – 50th St. Spirit River, AB T0H 3G0.

The complaint must be accompanied by a **\$50** fee for Residential and Farmland or **\$650** fee for Non-residential – Commercial or Industrial, *which will be refunded to the complainant if the complaint is successful.*

A copy of "Filing a Property Assessment Complaint and Preparing for Your Hearing" booklet, as well as a "Guide to Property Assessment and Taxation in Alberta" can be obtained @ [mdspiritriver.ab.ca](mailto:mdspiritriver.ab.ca).

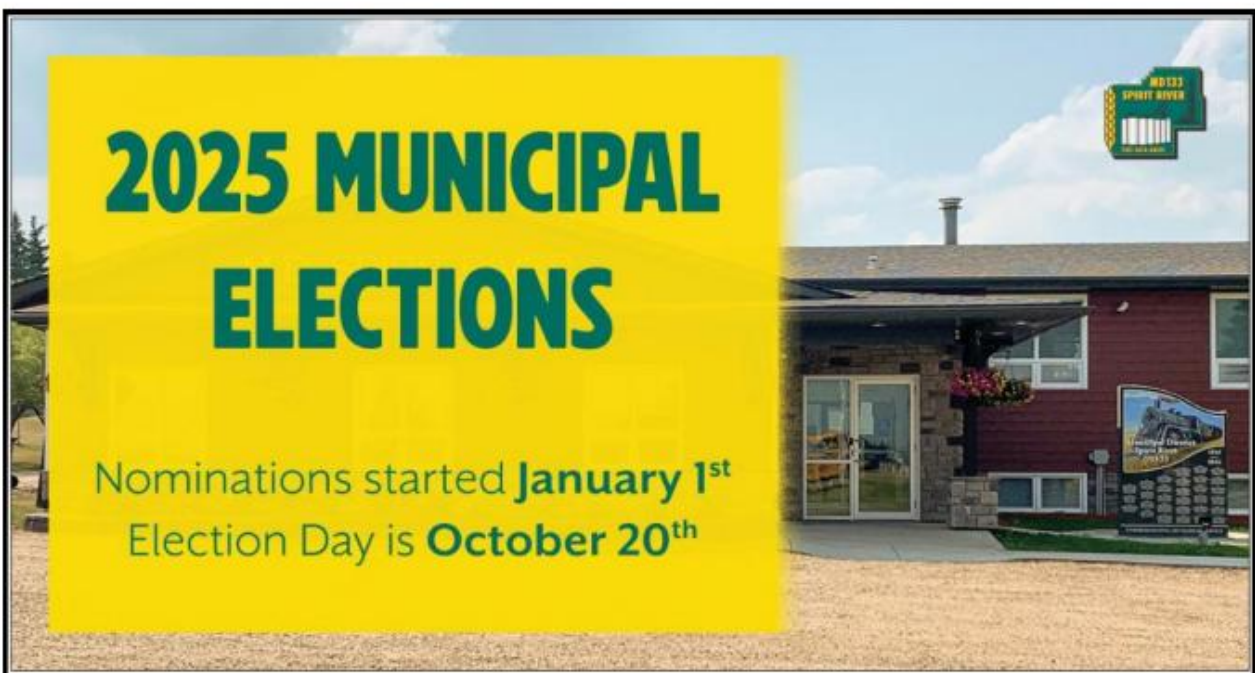

- ✓ All voters in the MD of Spirit River must be on the permanent Electors Registry.\*
- ✓ To register or check your registration status, visit the Voterlink website.
- ✓ The MD of Spirit River receives its list of eligible voters from Voterlink, so please confirm your information is correct to ensure you're ready to vote.

\* If you do not register beforehand, you will still be able to vote. However, you will be required to register at the voting station on Election Day.

*Just to note, pre-registering will make the voting process faster on Election Day.*

# Fire Ban

Due to ongoing very dry conditions, very warm weather and gusty winds, the **Fire Hazard is now Extreme**. As a result, open burning is not allowed within the borders of the MD # 133 of Spirit River, **Effective Immediately**.

Please exercise caution when conducting any activities in dry cured fuels.

No campfires (or other open fires) are allowed in campgrounds, residential fire pits or random camping areas. This includes charcoal briquettes.

Gas or propane stoves / barbeques and portable propane fire pits are allowed. Fires contained within industrial processes are allowed.

All existing controlled burns and fireworks permits are suspended or cancelled, and no new permits will be issued until conditions improve.

This **Fire Ban** will remain in place until conditions improve. Fire danger levels are reviewed daily. The Fire Ban will be downgraded when conditions improve.

If you see a wildfire, report it immediately by calling **9-1-1** or **310-FIRE**



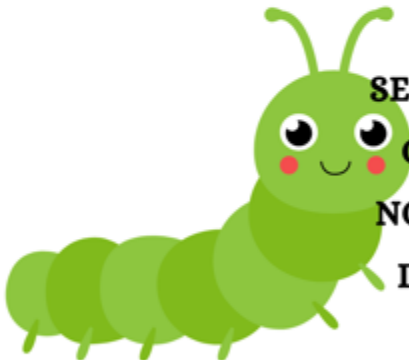
